Lamport Hall

Set within the rolling Northamptonshire countryside, Lamport Hall provides a secluded and atmospheric setting for your special day. With a stunning classical frontage and beautiful gardens, only a short drive from the motorway network and A14, Lamport Hall is perfect for you and your guests to enjoy this memorable occasion.

Bequeathed to the Lamport Hall Preservation Trust by Sir Gyles Isham in 1976, the Hall is now cared for by a team of dedicated staff and volunteers.







Where to Celebrate

There are two rooms licensed for civil ceremonies. However we never have more than one wedding at a time, therefore you can enjoy your special day with exclusivity.

The High Room

The High Room is the tallest space within Lamport Hall and as such provides a breathtaking setting for your special day.

The High Room can accommodate up to 50 guests.



The Oak Room

The Oak Room provides a stunning atmospheric touch to your day, with the staircase entrance for the bride.

The Oak Room can accommodate approximately 70 guests.

The Library

Both rooms have the option of signing the register in the Library.

Facility Hire

Civil Ceremony

- ❖ A preparation room for the bride and her entourage for 1 hour prior to the ceremony.
- ❖ A civil ceremony in the Oak Room or High Room, set up specifically for the number of guests you are expecting.
- ❖ The use of the gardens for 1 hour after the ceremony for photographs.
- Time for drinks and/or canapés after the ceremony. Catering surcharges apply.
- Off road parking.
- ❖ 3 hours venue hire.

Gardenia Package

- Civil Ceremony as above.
- The Victorian Dining Room for a seated wedding breakfast for up to 50 guests. Catering surcharges apply.
- ❖ 5 hours venue hire (finishing no later than 6.30pm).

Rose Package

- Civil Ceremony as above.
- ❖ The Hall for a relaxed standing wedding breakfast buffet for up to 70 guests. Catering surcharges apply.
- ❖ 5 hours venue hire (finishing no later than 6.30pm).

The facility hire includes the setting up of the rooms and the use of the premises as specified. All catering and other services are not included.

Our in-house staff can cater for drinks, canapés and wedding breakfasts.





Conditions

Lamport Hall is primarily a stately home which is lovingly conserved by its staff and volunteers for the benefit of the public. We therefore ask you to abide by the following conditions:

- ❖No confetti is to be thrown in the Hall or the gardens. In the gardens dried flower petals or bubbles make suitable alternatives.
 - Due to the valuable and delicate nature of the Hall and contents, dancing or loud music is not allowed (background music only).

❖No beer is allowed inside the Hall.

❖Only the official photographer may take photos inside the house. Guests may take photographs in the gardens.

Further Information

- ❖ Lamport is in the Northampton Registration District. Please contact the Northampton Registrars Office for more information and to book a registrar.
- Lamport Hall is non-residential but there is a good selection of hotel and guest accommodation in the area. Please contact the Northampton Tourist Information for more information.
- ❖ Anyone wishing to make a booking must complete a hiring agreement and agree to the conditions contained therein. A deposit of half the facility fee is payable to secure a booking and the balance is due prior to the event. All prices for hire only are zero rated for VAT. All drinks and catering packages are inclusive of VAT at the standard rate unless stated otherwise.
- ❖ All appointments must be within office hours, however it may be possible to arrange a visit at the weekend if the Hall is open for an event.
